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Definitions

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are
 called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing
 employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary
 institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which testate requires passing an examination, the six-month period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

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STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

ENROLLMENT CANCELLATION (WITHDRAWAL) - FULL REFUND

Students have the right to cancel their contract for enrollment at Five Branches University and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. To do so they must obtain a Withdrawal form from the Registrar's Office. If they are unable to do so, a letter, e-mail or fax addressed to the Registrar with the Student's signature stating your cancellation of enrollment will be accepted. Deadline to cancel program enrollment and obtain a full-refund:

If enrollment is canceled by the stipulated deadline, the University will refund the student any tuition monies paid, less a registration or administration fee not to exceed \$250.00, and less any deduction for equipment not returned in good condition, within 45 days after the notice of cancellation is received. CHANGE IN ENROLLMENT STATUS – DROPPED COURSE(S)

In order to receive a full refund, Students must cancel their registration for a course one week prior to the course start date. Courses dropped after this date and up until the first class meeting will receive a 50% refund, with the exception of a 1-day course which is non-refundable. Any course dropped after the first class meeting is non-refundable. Students who do not drop or do not show up for a registered course will be charged the full course registration fee.

If a course is cancelled subsequent to a Student's enrollment, and before instruction in the course has begun, the school will make a full refund of all tuition charges. If a course is discontinued after instruction has begun, the school will issue a pro-rated refund or provide completion options for the course. If a student is removed from classes or expelled from the University after instruction has begun, a refund for the canceled hours of enrollment will be returned to the Student. Credited amounts will be applied to the Student's account, or refunded upon request less any balance owing.
