

DAOM Program Overview

The postgraduate Doctor of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (DAOM) program is designed for licensed acupuncturists interested in developing advanced TCM knowledge and skills, achieving a medical specialization, and gaining valuable experience in research and teaching.

As a DAOM student you will:

- ❖ Expand and refine your knowledge and expertise in TCM patient care
- ❖ Gain the clinical treatment skills needed to work in an integrative medical setting
- ❖ Build professional relationships with TCM clinicians and other healthcare providers
- ❖ Develop yourself as a leader in the field of TCM as a practitioner, teacher or researcher

The DAOM program is offered at the San Jose campus in both English and Chinese. The two-year program is 1280 hours in length comprised of both didactic and clinical training. DAOM courses are offered once per month during three to four-day weekend intensives with a flexible clinical training schedule, allowing you to earn a doctorate degree in as little as 24 months while maintaining your private practice.

Externships and Travel Abroad

At Five Branches University we offer some of the most exclusive externships and study abroad programs. Through these programs you will be able to spend up to 25% of your clinical training hours out in real world situations and gain new perspectives on the medicine from teachers abroad.



Our local externship programs offer a broad range of settings; from settings providing you with valuable hands-on clinical experience in a private practice, to open community clinics, and cutting edge integrative medicine environment. We have externships at locations such as MHCAN (Mental Health Client Action Network), Highland Hospital, Veteran's clinics and more. These opportunities include working with a varied patient populations that will expose you to many real world situations not found in a classroom.



In our Study Abroad Program, accompanied by Five Branches' native speaking faculty and fellow classmates from our DTCM/MTCM and DAOM programs, you can travel to Asia for a period of two to four weeks to receive specialized TCM and Integrative Medicine training in an affiliated hospital and outpatient center at one of our five sister schools, in China, Taiwan, South Korea and Vietnam. Locations include schools such as Zhejiang Chinese Medical University, Liaoning University of TCM, Tianjin University of TCM, Daejeon University and many more.



Our Faculty

The Five Branches faculty has been carefully selected from experienced Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) and Western medicine teachers in the United States and China. Many of our faculty have studied under TCM Masters from China and have over 40 years experience practicing and teaching TCM. The majority of our Chinese faculty trained in China's most prestigious TCM universities and hospitals, such as Shanghai University of TCM, Beijing University of Chinese Medicine, Guangzhou Sun Yat Sen Medical University, Liaoning University of TCM, Fujian University of TCM, and Zhejiang Chinese Medical University. Our faculty also includes seasoned medical doctors who teach academic and clinical Western Medicine courses.

As a student of Five Branches you will learn from highly skilled and experienced teachers who bring a strong foundation of both Chinese and Western medicine into the classroom. You will have the opportunity to absorb their wisdom through direct teaching, and to observe the intangible qualities of compassion and caring in their interactions with patients. You will experience faculty who are passionate about Chinese medicine, interested in achieving academic excellence, and who are eager to assist you with your personal growth and success as a TCM practitioner.

Tuition & Financial Aid

Tuition for the DTCM/MTCM Dual Degree program at Five Branches University is averaged at \$5,800 per trimester. It is recommended to complete the program in 11 consecutive terms. Need based Federal funding and Grad Plus loans are available for those who qualify through FAFSA. Limited amounts of funding is also offered through scholarships.

All applicants must have fulfilled the minimum education requirements of 90 semester credits (equivalent to 135 quarter credits) of general education from a regionally accredited degree-granting college or university, with a minimum 3.00 GPA.

Tuition for our 1280-hour DAOM program tuition is \$20,000, to be paid over a period of two years. Need based Federal Financial Aid is available and limited scholarships are available as well.
